	PRIZE TITLE	AWARD CRITERIA
	Best New Apprentice	For apprentices who commenced in 2021. They need to nominate themselves explaining in minimum 100 words how their apprenticeship is progressing.
	Best Retail Butchery Apprentice / Student	Close to completion or within 6 months of completion. Nominated by training provider with an accompanying statement from the employer within the independent retail sector. One nomination per centre only.
	Best Independent Retailer Meat Apprentice	Close to completion or within 6 months of completion. Nominated by training provider with an accompanying statement from the employer within the independent retail sector. One nomination per centre only.
	Best Multiple Retailer Meat Apprentice	Close to completion or within 6 months of completion. Nominated by training provider with an accompanying statement from the employer within the multiple retail sector. One nomination per centre only.
	Best Meat Processing Apprentice	Close to completion or within 6 months of completion. Nominated by training provider with an accompanying statement from employer within the processing sector. One nomination per centre only.
	Best Abattoir Worker /Apprentice	For workers and/or apprentices in the abattoir industry who commenced a training programme (WATOK) or apprenticeship in 2021. Applicants need to nominate themselves explaining in minimum 100 words how their course/apprenticeship is providing benefit.
	Best Apprentice Showing Management Potential in a Manufacturing Environment	Nominated by training provider with an accompanying statement from employer within the processing sector. One nomination per centre only.
	Best Meat Apprentice Showing Retail Management Potential	Someone who joined meat industry in last 3 years who is demonstrating exceptional management or leadership.
	Lord Graham Endeavour Award	An apprentice who has made real progress despite adversity. Nominated by employer or training provider, with minimum 100 words from the apprentice describing why they followed the apprenticeship and what they have achieved.
	Best Company Training Scheme	Nominate a company or satellite and produce a statement to justify the nomination, maximum 2 A4 sheets.
	Best Meat Training Provider of the Year	Nominate a training provider or college and produce a statement to justify the nomination, maximum 2 A4 sheets.
	Champion Apprentice of the Year	This award will be decided by the awards committee. The recipient will be chosen from the winners of categories 1 to 9.
